## **Hazlewood Exemption Application Packet For Veterans**

(HE-V)

The HE-V application is for veterans who wish to apply for Hazlewood benefits as new or previous recipients OR to request their unused hours be transferred to an eligible child.

\* Contact your institution to find out where and when you should submit the application and supporting documentation. The institution will process your application accordingly. Do <u>NOT</u> mail the application to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

### Hazlewood Exemption Application for Veterans who have Never Used the Exemption

#### **Eligibility Requirements and Documentation**

In order to qualify for a tuition and partial fee exemption through the Texas Education Code 54.341 (known as the Hazlewood Act), a person must meet all program requirements. The following is a list of program requirements and how they are documented.

Eligibility Requirement	Application Questions	Documentation
Not in default on a loan made or guaranteed by the state of Texas. These loans include the College Access Loan Program (CAL), the Health Education Loan Program (HELP), the state's Federal Family Education Loan Program (FFELP) and the Texas B-On-Time Loan Program (BOT). Federal loans are not included.	Question 5	Applicants with loans made through the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board must log into <a href="https://www.HHLoans.com">www.HHLoans.com</a> and print their student loan report to provide to the institution. Applicants without a loan with THECB will be verified by the institution and the program administrator at THECB.
If eligible for federal veteran's education benefits under Ch. 33 Post 911 GI Bill or Ch. 31 Vocational Rehab, the value of these benefits cannot exceed the value of the Hazlewood exemption. If you have served additional active duty since your discharge, your federal education benefits letter must be current and no more than 3 months old.	Questions 6 and 7	Benefit letter from VA Education Center in Muskogee, Oklahoma, 1-888-GI-Bill-1 or 1-888-442-4551 or <a href="www.gibill.va.gov">www.gibill.va.gov</a> .  If the veteran has not served since 9/11, he/she does NOT have to provide a copy of his/her federal veteran's education benefits letter. If the veteran has served since 9/11 then a letter is required.
Eligible veterans must have met one of the following requirements at the "time of entry" into the service:  • Entered the service in Texas;  • Declared Texas as home of record, or  • Was a Texas resident.	Question 8	DD214 shows place of entry and home of record at time of entry.  If the DD214 shows HOR and Place of Entry were both not Texas, you must complete the Hazlewood Residency Questionnaire and submit it with your application. A copy of that questionnaire is included in this packet.
Veterans who receive the Hazlewood Exemption for the first time beginning on or after fall 2011 must reside in the State of Texas during the semester or term for which you claim the exemption.	Question 9	Veterans must provide proof to the institution that he/she is residing in Texas during the semester that the exemption is to be used.
Have an honorable or general under honorable conditions discharge or separation.	Question 10	DD214 shows character of service. The Hazlewood administrator will review this document.
Served at least 181 days of active duty (excluding training).	Question 11	DD214 shows dates of service and days of active duty. The Hazlewood administrator will review this document.

#### **Documents to Submit**

To apply for an Exemption, you must submit the following documents to your institution:

- 1. The Hazlewood Exemption Application for Veterans
- 2. **DD214** for use in verifying your service-entry status, character of service, length of service, and dates of service. Make sure the copy you provide your institution includes all relevant information.

- 3. **Benefits letter from Muskogee, Oklahoma** to verify the value of your federal veteran's education benefits (Ch 33 or CH 31) that you are receiving. 1-888-442-4551
- 4. **Hazlewood Residency Questionnaire for Veterans** If you did not enter the service in Texas or declare Texas as your Home of Record when you entered the service, you must have been a resident of Texas when you entered in order to qualify for Hazlewood.
- 5. **Proof of Online Database Registration** All applicants (veteran and dependents) must register online in order to track hours used through the program. Once registered applicants must login and print a verification page for the institution.

# Instructions for Completing the Hazlewood Exemption Residency Questionnaire for Veterans

#### The Residency Questionnaire is NOT required for persons who answered "yes" to 8a or 8b.

Part A	Self-explanatory
Part B	A veteran was a Texas resident for higher education purposes if he or she graduated from a Texas high school or received a GED in Texas having lived in the state for the 36 months leading up to graduation or the receipt of a GED and he or she also lived in Texas the 12 months prior to enlistment. The 12-month period may overlap the 36-month period leading up to graduation or receipt of GED.
Part C	Residency of a minor or dependent who did not meet the requirements outlined in Part B is based on the residency of the parent or legal guardian who claimed him/her as a dependent for federal income tax purposes. Residency of an independent, self-supporting person is based on his/her own circumstances. Answers to C impact which parts of the application will need to be completed to determine your residency classification when you entered the service.
D1-D3	These questions should only be answered by individuals who do not meet the requirements outlined in Part B and who were independent, self-supporting when they entered the service and who filed their own federal income tax at that time as an independent tax payer.
E1-E7	These questions should only be answered by individuals who do not meet the requirements outlined in Part B and were claimed as dependents by a parent or legal guardian at the time they entered the service.
Part F	This section is provided for you to add comments if you believe there is additional information the school should have to determine your residency at the time you entered the service.
Part G	This section must be read and signed by all individuals applying for an exemption.
